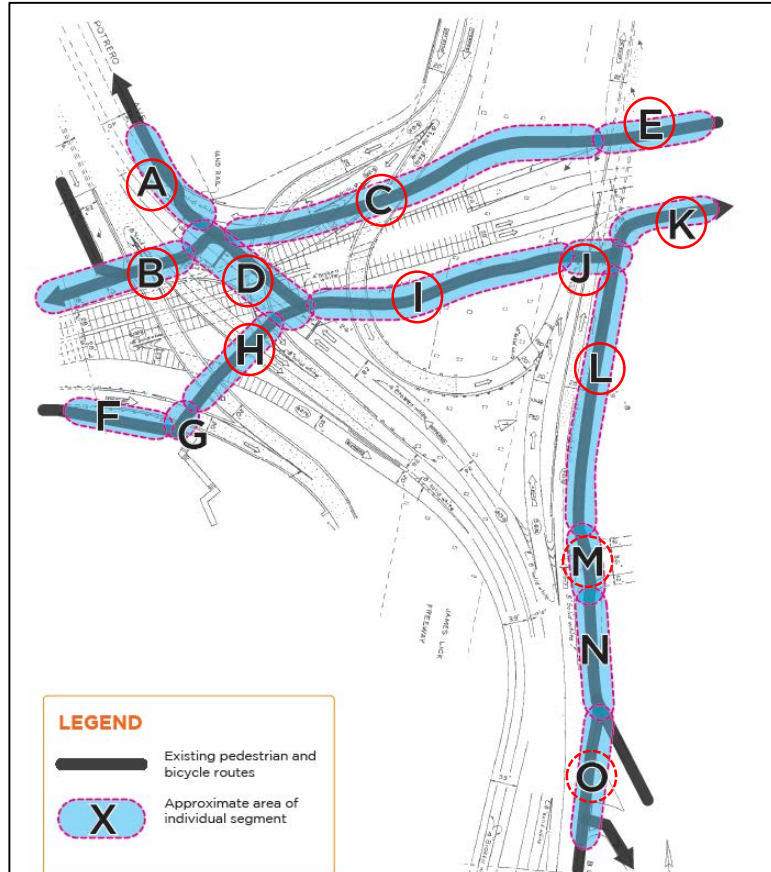

Prop K request: \$480,000

**Continuous, accessible and safe series of
bicycle and pedestrian pathways**

**Connects neighborhoods and vital
destinations**

Scope:

- Upgrades at key crossings – concrete and asphalt raised crosswalks, flashing pedestrian beacons
- New/ upgraded bicycle lanes
- Wheelchair accessibility/safety improvements with additional striping and new (wider) curb ramps

Design done by Spring 2021

Bicycle Safety Education and Outreach (SFMTA) Construction



Prop K request: \$100,000

Classes for 1000+ adults and kids, encourages bicycling and bike safety

Fall 2020 to Dec 2021

- Adult Learn-to-Ride
- Smart City Cycling
- Youth Freedom from Training Wheels
- Night and All-Weather Biking
- On-Bike Practice for Adult Beginning Cyclists
- Sharing City Streets

Prop AA request: \$383,776

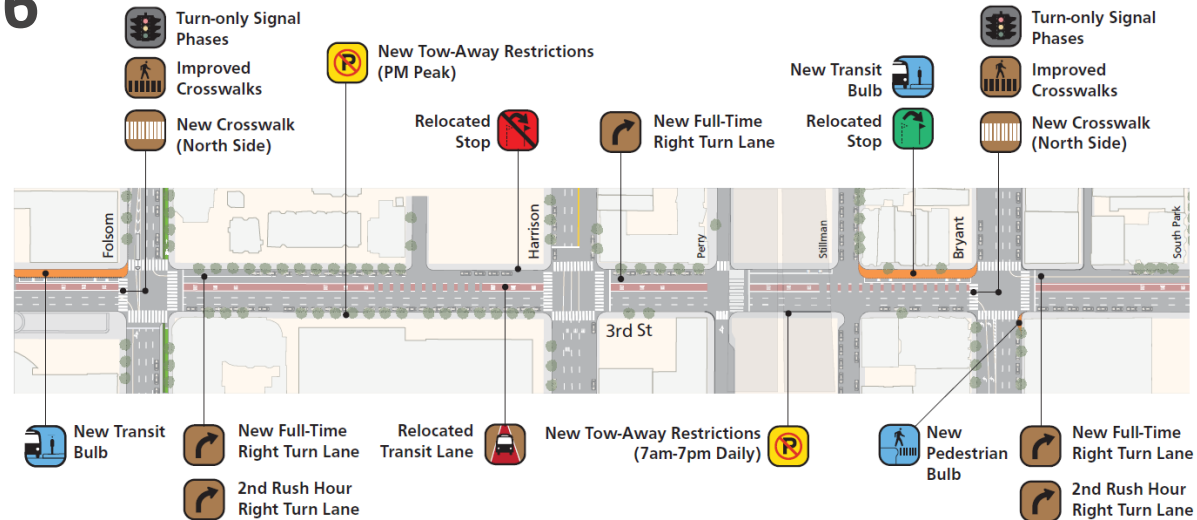
Total Cost: \$2,883,776

Reduce bus delays and improve
pedestrian safety

Implement Phase 2 of 3

- At Folsom, Harrison, Bryant, and Townsend: transit-friendly signal hardware modifications
- At Townsend: transit-only queue-jump turn lane

Open for use July 2021
