


Golden Gate Greenway (SFMTA) Design Engineering

Prop L request: \$140,000 Total Cost: \$240,000

Project will create a car-lite, public space with activation and programming in partnership with the Tenderloin community

- Reduce 100 block of Golden Gate Ave from two lanes to one vehicle traffic lane, reconfigure overhead catenary wires, and relocate fire hydrant
- Construction funded by federal Safe Streets for All grant and future Prop L for local match
- Open for use by September 2027



The Golden Gate Greenway will sit between Leavenworth and Jones Streets, which are part of the High Injury Network.



Transit Stop Signage Enhancement Program - Phase 2

(SFMTA) Construction

Prop AA request: \$1,021,021 Total Cost: \$1,021,021

Produce and install updated and upgraded signage at Muni stops with new transit stop poles where possible

- New, more legible signage with route, stop, and accessibility information
- Muni-branded solar powered lanterns will be prioritized for stops along rapid or frequent lines
- Open for use by December 2027
