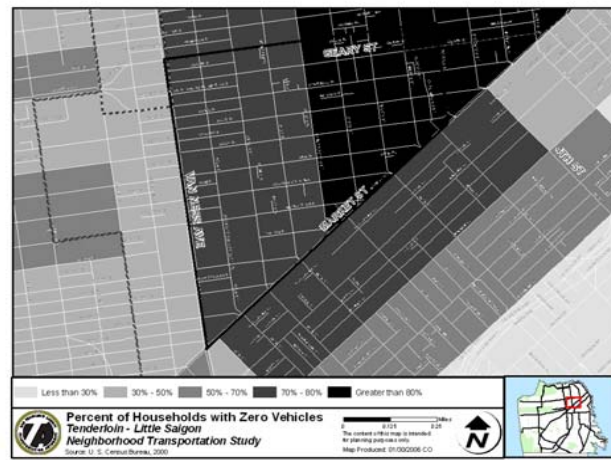
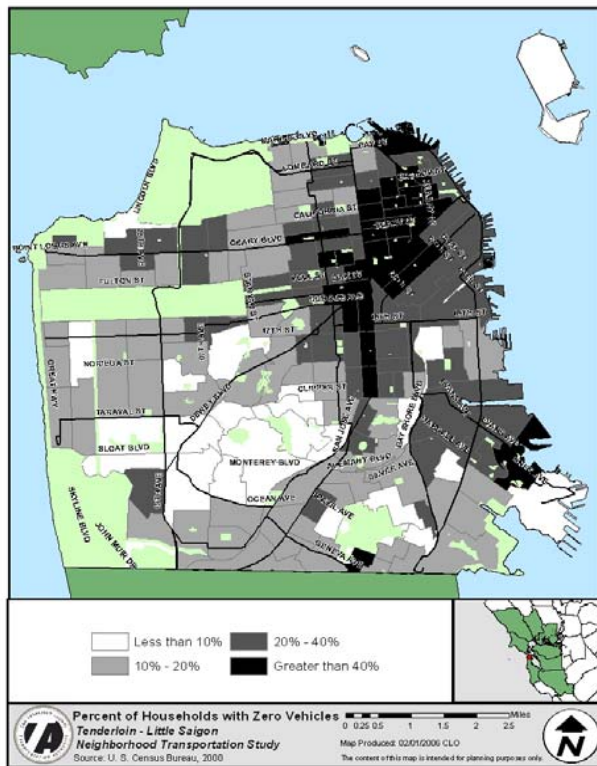


HOW TENDERLOIN RESIDENTS GET AROUND

The transportation profile of the Tenderloin is unique within San Francisco

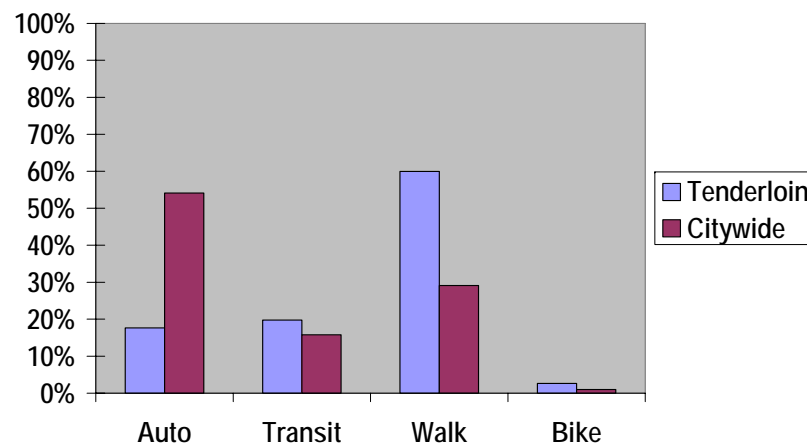
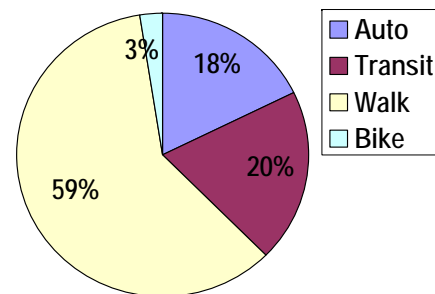
Tenderloin Residents Own Fewer Cars than the Average San Franciscan

What We Heard from You

- Many people reported that they don't drive and don't own a car
- Many people reported that they walk for most of their trips

Key Technical Findings

- 82% of Tenderloin households do not have a car
- Most trips made by Tenderloin residents are by walking
- Tenderloin residents' travel patterns are very different from the average San Franciscan
 - Tenderloin residents are much more likely to walk, bike, and take transit
 - Tenderloin households are much less likely to own a car
- People who work in the Tenderloin are more likely to drive than are Tenderloin residents
