Study Budget and Schedule



- ☐ Study funding:
 - ☐ Total study budget including agency, consultant, contingency: \$1.8 million
 - □ \$500,000 currently funded with Prop K
 - ☐ Anticipated funding sources for remaining \$1.3 million: MTC, developer fees
 - ☐ Full \$700,000 consultant contract contingent upon full funding
- ☐ Schedule:
 - ☐ Complete by end of 2020

 - ☐ Workstream 2: Program Development

Procurement Overview



- ☐ RFP Issued: April 8, 2019
- ☐ Proposal Due Date: May 7, 2019
- 5 proposals received by RFP deadline
- 3 firms interviewed by evaluation committee comprised of TA, SFMTA and MTC staff
- ☐ All 3 interviewed firms met or exceeded 14% DBE goal

Key Evaluation Criteria



- Proposer Information and Understanding of ProjectObjectives
- Technical and Management Approach
- Capabilities and Experience

Staff Recommendation



- Award an 18-month contract in an amount not to exceed \$700,000 to the top-ranked firm:
 - □ Nelson\Nygaard Consulting Associates
- Authorize the Executive Director to negotiate contract payment terms and non-material terms and conditions
