### **Prop AA**

**Overview** 



San Francisco **County Transportation** 

- **\$10 vehicle registration fee**
- **Generates about \$5 million** annually
- Focus on small, high impact projects that will provide tangible benefits to the public quickly
- **Design and construction phases** only
- Strong emphasis on timely use of  $\bullet$ funds

#### **Prop AA Categories**

50%

### STREET REPAIR AND RECONSTRUCTION

Reconstruction of city streets with priority given to streets located on:

- Bicycle network
- Transit network

Priority to projects that include complete streets elements, including:

- Pedestrian improvements
- Traffic calming
- Bicycle infrastructure

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#### **PEDESTRIAN SAFETY**

- Crosswalk maintenance
- Sidewalk repair and widening
- Sidewalk bulb-outs
- Pedestrian lighting, signals, and median islands

#### TRANSIT RELIABILITY AND MOBILITY IMPROVEMENTS

- Transit station/stop improvements
- Transit signal priority
- Travel information improvements
- Parking management pilots
- Transportation demand management



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Funds available: \$4,140,270

- \$3,550,072 initial amount
- \$590,198 from Capital Reserve and completed projects
- Six applications requesting: \$5,978,052
- Recommendation: Program \$4,140,270 to five projects



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#### Board-adopted prioritization criteria:

- Eligibility screening criteria
- Program-wide criteria (e.g. community support)
- Category-specific criteria (e.g. for Pedestrian category, prioritize projects on the High Injury Network)

- Accessible Pedestrian Signals (SFMTA) -\$249,930
- Lowest scoring Pedestrian Safety application
- SFCTA staff will work with SFMTA to identify other funds (e.g. Prop K funds from the Signals and Signs or Pedestrian Safety categories).
