New 2020 RTIP Programming Priorities

1. Planning Programming and Monitoring

2. New Flyer Midlife Overhaul – Phase III (SFMTA) - \$7,174,000





New Flyer Midlife Overhaul - Phase III (SFMTA) - Construction



Scheduled mid-life overhauls of 40-foot and 60-foot electric trolley or motor coaches

- Improves reliability, prevents service interruptions, reduces maintenance costs
- Exterior painting, updating seating configurations, improving wheelchair securements





2020 RTIP-funded contract:

- Thirteen vehicles
- Total cost: \$9,101,000
- Commence in 2026

- December 18 MTC approves 2020 RTIP
