# Incorporates recommendations from independent oversight report by T.Y. Lin

- Implement Oversight Protocol
- Reimbursement of first \$31.5 million in Prop K funds conditioned upon Phase 1 vehicles (68 expansion) passing Reliability Demonstration Test
- By September 1, 2020 SFMTA provide plan describing preventive maintenance program for new vehicles
- Maintain the new LRVs in a state of good repair, including mid-life overhauls
- Strategic Plan amendment
