#### \$10 annual vehicle registration fee

- ~\$5 million annually
- 50% street repair/reconstruction
- 25% pedestrian safety
- 25% transit reliability and mobility improvements

### Prop AA Project Delivery Update

Since inception, \$37.4 million allocated to 31 projects

- 19 projects open for use
- 12 projects underway

## Prop AA Timely Use of Funds Requirement

Request allocation of funds in year of programming or project may, at the discretion of the Transportation Authority Board, have funding reprogrammed to other, ready-to-go projects through a competitive call
