







SEGMENT	ESTIMATED COST	POTENTIAL FUNDING
Hillcrest Road/Treasure Island Road (to above the YBI Tunnel)	\$40-50 M	\$30M Infill Infrastructure Grant (secured); SF Local Partnership Program and Regional PCA funds (Env/Design), Regional Measure 3, ATP, new funding measures and grants.
West Side Bridges: connection to Treasure Island Ferry Terminal	\$35-40 M
