# Marin St. & Napoleon Avenue Bridges (PCJPB) Construction

Prop K request: \$180,624 Prop K allocated: ~\$1.341M Total cost: \$16.4M

- Retrofit or replace bridge elements to extend useful life of structures
- Install additional fencing and fill material to bridge superstructure

Open for use December 2021







# L-Taraval Transit Enhancements (Segment B) (SFMTA) Construction

Prop AA request: \$3,664,159 Prop K request: \$4,055,032 Prop K allocated: \$11.2 million Total cost: \$66.5 million



- Transit reliability and pedestrian safety improvements
- West Portal to Sunset Boulevard
- Part of larger project (street resurfacing, sewer and water infrastructure upgrades)
- Open for use Fall 2023

# Fulton Street Safety [NTIP Capital] (SFMTA) Construction

#### Prop K request: \$236,215

#### Implement NTIP Planning project recommendations

- Daylighting (34 intersections), painted safety zones (14 locations)
- Signalized bike connections at 10<sup>th</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenues
- Pave existing dirt path in Golden Gate Park at 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue
- Speed radar sign at 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue

Open for use by March 2021

# Prop K request: \$420,000

#### Install traffic signal upgrades

- Poles, larger traffic signals with higher visibility, pedestrian countdown signals
- SFPW will lead construction
- Scope incorporated into sub-sidewalk basement curb ramp project
  Open for use by Fall 2021

#### Bayview Community Based Transportation Plan Implementation (SFMTA) Design

San Francisco County Transportation Authority

**Prop K request: \$180,000** Pedestrian safety improvements at high priority locations

Two Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons -Innes Avenue/Arelious Walker -Williams Avenue/Apollo Street

Up to nine bulbouts

-Locations to be confirmed with District Supervisor's office and community stakeholders Design done by December 2021





# 6<sup>th</sup> Street Pedestrian Safety (SFMTA) Construction

Prop K request: \$4,000,000

Total cost: \$19,226,200

Implement pedestrian safety improvements between Market and Brannan Streets

Project includes:

- Removal of one southbound vehicle traffic lane
- Widening sidewalks
- 5 new marked crosswalks
- 23 pedestrian bulbouts
- New traffic signal infrastructure

Open for use June 2023





# Short-Term Bicycle Parking (SFMTA) Construction

Prop K request: \$398,000 Total cost: \$1,173,481 Site and install at least 1,420 bike racks citywide

- Locations by public request and proactive siting in underserved areas
- Leverages TFCA and bike share/scooter share permit revenues

Open for use June 2022





# Slow Streets Program (SFMTA) Construction



San Francisco County Transportation Authority

### Prop K request: \$1,175,400

Reduce ongoing maintenance, provide space for socially distanced walking and biking, support economic recovery and buildout of citywide bicycle network

Durable materials (flexible delineators, signage) to:

- Replace temporary barricades on 17 existing Slow Streets
- Implement 14 additional Slow Streets

Evaluate effectiveness using traffic counts and surveys

Open for use by Spring 2022



# Golden Gate Park Sustainable Travel Study [NTIP Planning] (SFCTA)



San Francisco County Transportation Authority

### Prop K request: \$60,000

Review closure of JFK Drive in Golden Gate Park

- Requested by Commissioners Fewer and Mar
- Convene working group of city agencies, public institutions, and community groups
- Identify and analyze concerns
- Develop consensus for long-term strategy

Final study report to CAC and Board in early 2021
