

Project Background - YBI Projects





Hillcrest Road Project Key Features



- Widen existing road up to 40' to meet SFPW standards
 - Retaining walls, new pavement, utilities/joint trench
- Connects Westside Bridges Project to Southgate Project
- YBI Multi-use Pathway within Hillcrest Project Limits
- Prepare YBI Multi-use Pathway for future connection to BATA's Bay Bridge West Span Skyway Project and Treasure Island Ferry Terminal

Hillcrest Road Project Limits






YBI Multi-use Path Environmental



- YBI Multi-use Pathway Project is a separate but overlapping project encompassing a transportation network for pedestrians and cyclists
- Environmental documentation from the Macalla Road/Treasure Island Road intersection to the SFOBB East Span YBI Viewing (bike) Landing
- Portion of YBI Multi-use Pathway within Hillcrest Limits

Hillcrest/ YBI Multi-use Pathway






YBI Pathway - Southgate Road




- Two-way Class 1

- 1. PSE 35%
- 2. PSE 65%
- 3. PSE 95%
- 4. PSE Final
- 5. Permits and Agreements
- 6. Construction Estimates



RFP Key Information



- Contract term: 2 year
- Contract budget: \$3,000,000
- **DBE/SBE Goal:** 15%
 - See RFP Section VII (page 21) for accepted certifications
 - Firms must be certified by RFP due date

RFP Scoring



Evaluation criteria (100 points):

- Proposer Information and Understanding of Project
 Objectives (15 points)
- Technical and Management Approach (40 points)
- Capabilities and Experience (45 points)

RFP Submittal Requirements



- Proposal: 1 electronic copy (PDF) without cost proposal
 - Limited to 15 pages
 - Page limit excludes resumes, exhibits, etc. (RFP page 13)
- Cost proposal: 1 electronic copy (XLS/XLSX format)
 - Must be submitted separately from proposal
 - Hourly billing rates + hours/costs by person/task (RFP page 19)
- Exhibits (RFP page 17)
