#### Purposes of Communities of Concern (CoCs) Designation

#### Prioritizing funding

 e.g. One Bay Area Grant, Lifeline, Community-Based Transportation Plans, Prop K, Prop AA, TFCA

Analyzing equity of impacts and outcomes

 e.g. Plan Bay Area, Vision Zero traffic collisions, San Francisco Transportation Plan



#### **MTC CoC Disadvantaged Factors**



DISADVANTAGED FACTOR	CONCENTRATION THRESHOLD
People of Color	70%
Low Income (<200% Federal Poverty Level)	28%
Limited English Proficiency	12%
Zero-Vehicle Household	15%
Seniors 75 Years and Over	8%
People with Disability	12%
Single-Parent Family	18%
Cost-Burdened Renter	14%

#### **MTC CoC Definition**



CoCs must meet or exceed concentration thresholds for:

1) People of Color + Low Income


OR

2) Low Income + three of the six remaining factors

(Limited English Proficiency, Zero Vehicle Household, Seniors 75+, People with Disability, Single-Parent Family, Cost-Burdened Renter)





SFCTA 2021 supplemental Communities of Concern boundaries\*










#### 2017 vs. 2021 Proposed CoCs
