1. Purpose: Establish the framework of a coordinated effort to plan, fund, operate and administer Treasure Island Ferry Service
2. Goal: Zero emission vessel ferry service



3. Treasure Island Ferry Service Plan:

- Complete Ferry Planning Study to determine service plan, operation cost, fare, vessel size and type and other infrastructure parameters

4. Funding:

- TIMMA and WETA to collaborate and coordinate to pursue funding for zero-emission vessel procurement, operating costs or other capital costs.

5. Facilities and Administration

Recommendations

- Approve Treasure Island Ferry Service MOU with WETA
 - Ferry Planning Study to recommend Treasure Island ferry service plan, operating cost estimates and other parameters
 - Collaborating and coordinate with WETA to pursue funding for zero-emission vessel
- MOU to be effective till the completion of the Ferry Planning Study

2. Task 2 - Ferry Operating Analysis
3. Task 3 - Cost and Fare Revenue Analysis
4. Task 4 - Technical Advisory Committee
5. Task 5 - Final Report and Recommendations



Task 1 - Updated Demand and Service Plan

1. Early Service Plan (2022) - Frequency, vessel (existing), operating costs
2. Ultimate Service Plan - (2024 - 2040) - Frequency, vessel size, fuel type, operating costs
3. Peer Ferry Service Review

Schedule - February to July 2021

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Task 2 - Operational Analysis

1. Service Plan Alternatives
2. Develop ferry service operating schedule

Schedule - May to July 2021



Task 3 - Cost and Fare Revenue Analysis

1. Estimate capital costs for charging infrastructure or other capital expenses
2. Recommend ferry fare structure

Schedule - June to August 2021
