## Interviews with 8 community-based organizations

Transit	<ul> <li>Highest priority in some communities, especially with transit-dependent populations</li> <li>Maintenance should be included</li> <li>Affordability concerns - Support for paratransit</li> </ul>	
Safety & Security	<ul> <li>Safe streets, particularly pedestrian safety</li> <li>Public safety concerns</li> <li>Make Quick-Builds permanent</li> <li>Traffic signal upgrades</li> </ul>

## Interviews with 8 community-based organizations

#### - Focus investments in low-income neighborhoods Equity - In-language materials, including maps and transit information - Affordability concerns - Lack of yellow school buses makes getting to School school difficult **Transportation** - Additional buses are needed that serve schools

# Street Safety & Accessibility

- Safer pedestrian crossings and access
- Separated bike lanes
- Additional traffic signals

## Transit

- Overcrowding concerns Late night transportation needs
- Reliability improvements and transit lanes
- Bus connections between communities (vs. downtown)
- Additional transportation to/from schools
- Safety & accessibility on transit, including more lighting

## Equity

- Invest more in transportation, especially in low-income communities
- Ensure all communities have good access to transportation
- Transit affordability concerns

Focus Groups in Spanish, Chinese, and Russian/English

### **Street Resurfacing**

- Paving is essential for all modes
- Potholes present safety concerns

## **Traffic Congestion**

- Desire to improve flow of traffic
- Synchronize traffic signals
- Congestion getting on/off Bay Bridge

## Street Closures/Parking

- Concerns about street closures increasing congestion and reducing parking
- Parking solutions: app to find shared parking, stacked parking, additional garages

<ul> <li>Improve transit</li> <li>Better connections</li> <li>Additional service</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Primary concern for many</li> <li>Improve pedestrian safety, including crosswalks and lighting</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Think about who benefits from investments</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Balance improvements with need for parking</li> <li>Loading space is needed</li> </ul>
