Toll Policies

Adopted 2019: Current resident don't pay toll

Adopted 2021: Current nonprofits and food services will receive cash subsidies to offset the cost of the toll

Proposed for Adoption in Dec.:

- \$5.00 maximum toll
- Future moderate- & low-income drivers receive 50% toll discount
- Lowest income drivers don't pay toll
