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Enhance pedestrian and bicycle safety

Reduce multi-modal merging conflicts at off-ramp

Project prioritized in Balboa Park Station Area Circulation Study (2014)

Caltrans approved PSR/PR



Scope of Work



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Widening of existing ramp to two lanes with new roadbed and traffic signal

New pedestrian crosswalk signal, sidewalk, and ADA curb ramps

Retaining wall along City College property line

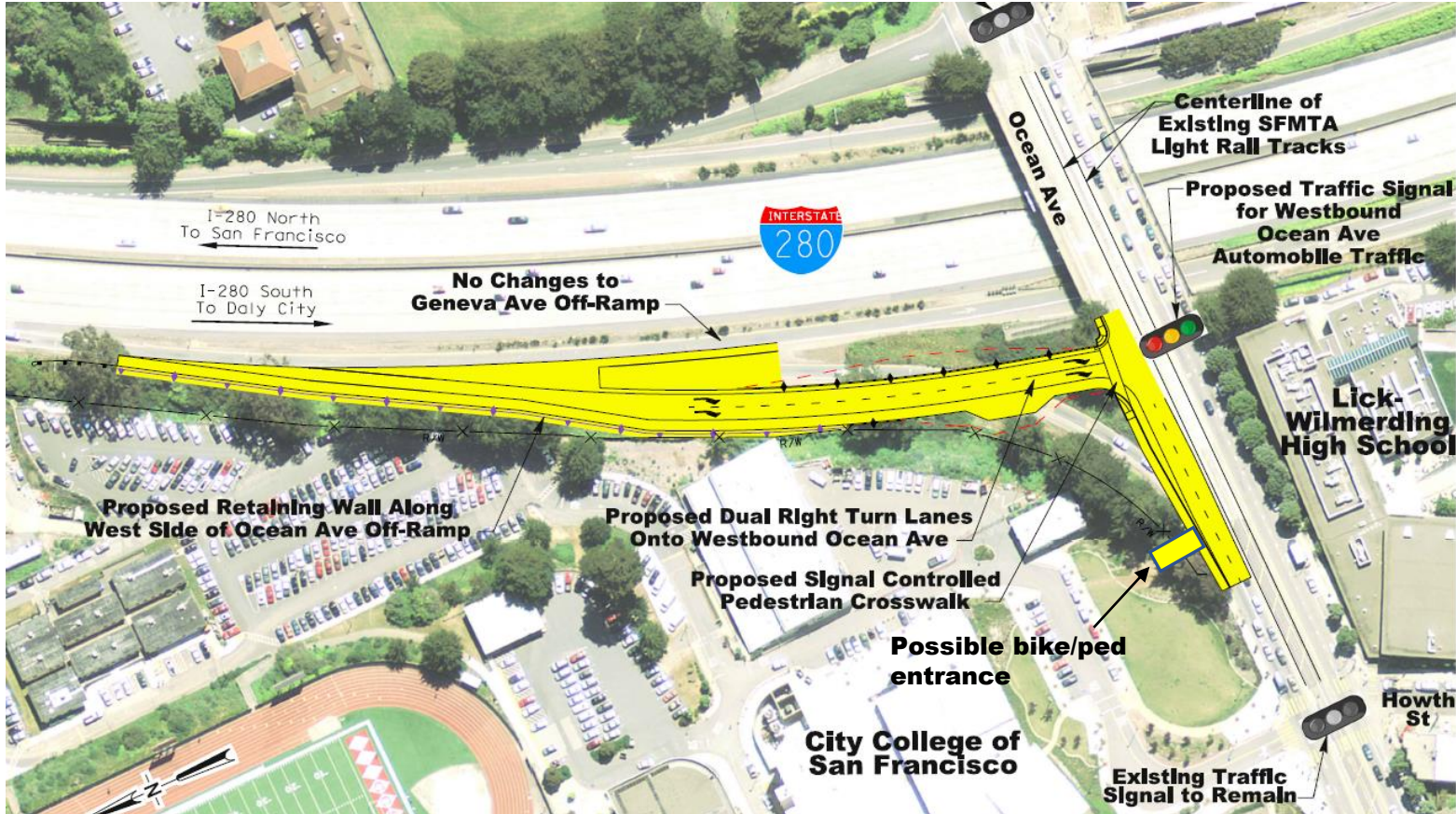
Coordination with SFMTA on possible bike lane along Ocean Avenue

Utility relocation and landscape treatment

DBE/SBE Goal: 15%

Firms must be certified by the proposal due date

Accepted certifications:

- **DBE certification from the California Unified Certification Program**
- **SBE or DVBE certification from the California Department of General Services**
- **LGBTBE certification from the California Public Utilities Commission Supplier Clearinghouse**

Additional Proposal Requirements



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RFP > Section V

- **By the proposal due date, primes and subconsultants must submit:**
 - **Exhibit A - Terminated Contracts**
 - **Exhibit B - Workforce Data Spreadsheets**
 - **Exhibit 10-H - Sample Cost Proposal (separate from technical proposal)**

- **Prior to contract execution:**
 - **The selected prime and subconsultants are subject to an Indirect Cost Rate financial review**

1. **Proposal Information and Understanding of Project Objectives (20 points)**
2. **Technical and Management Approach (40 points)**
3. **Capabilities and Experience (40 points)**
