

Geary/19th Ave Subway Strategic Case

(SFCTA, SFMTA, SF Planning) Planning

Prop K request: \$802,264

Building on the ConnectSF Transit Investment Strategy, develop a Strategic Case to establish worthiness of project and identify building blocks needed to deliver gradeseparated rail in the Geary/19th Avenue corridor.



Geary/19th Ave Subway Strategic Case (SFCTA, SFMTA, SF Planning) Planning

Key scope elements:

- Define project parameters and universe of alternatives
- Confirm and describe high-level benefits and costs
- Develop initial planning framework
- Identify key strategy considerations and project risks
- Engagement & outreach
- Preparation for Alternatives Analysis phase:
 - Roles & responsibilities
 - Full scope of work, including outreach and engagement



Geary/19th Ave Subway Strategic Case (SFCTA, SFMTA, SF Planning) Planning

Key deliverables include:

- Public-facing documentation of benefits of a rail investment, inventory of issues that will be addressed in future phases
- Internal scoping document detailing scope of work for alternatives analysis, refinement, and selection, including roles and responsibilities of San Francisco and regional partner agencies

Study expected to occur over 12-18 months, with a final report presented for Board approval in mid-2023



Bicycle Facility Maintenance (SFMTA) Construction

Prop K request: \$400,000

Maintain existing bicycle facilities to preserve their safety features

SFMTA Paint Shop will

- repaint bicycle lanes using green epoxy
- repaint bike box/ mixed zone facilities using green thermoplastic
- replace plastic lane delineators along buffered bikeways

Funds used by December 2024





Bicycle Facility Maintenance (SFMTA) Construction

Location prioritization

No current backlog of bicycle facilities in need of maintenance

Locations prioritized for maintenance based on:

- Field review by Livable Streets and SFMTA Shops staff as they go about their duties
- Public requests regarding the protected bikeway network and quick-build project locations.
