# Approve \$1,035,626 in San Francisco Lifeline Transportation Program Cycle 2 Funds for BART's Elevator Attendant Program



## Overview -STA Block Grant Program

Transit-focused program established by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) in 2018

Administered by Congestion Management Agencies

Revenues from state sales tax on diesel fuel, volatile funding source



## Overview -STA Block Grant Program continued

Funds may be used for capital transit improvements and operations; only transit operators may receive funds

San Francisco has programmed STA Block Grant funds to:

- SFMTA's paratransit program
- SF Lifeline Transportation Program (LTP)



#### **SF LTP Overview**



- SF LTP supports projects that improve mobility for low-income residents
- Projects that address gaps or barriers identified through equity assessments and collaborative and inclusive community-based planning processes
- Cycle 1 covered Fiscal Years (FYs) 2018/19-2019/20
- Cycle 2 covers FYs 2020/21-2021/22

#### **Elevator Attendant Program (BART)**



SF LTP funds recommended: \$1,035,626 Total cost: \$3,000,000

Improve safety, mobility, and accessibility for BART and SFMTA customers who rely on the elevators to access the four downtown shared stations: Civic Center/UN Plaza, Powell Street, Montgomery Street, and Embarcadero

Helps fund elevator attendants for FY 2022/23 BART & SFMTA contribute equally to the cost Quarterly reporting on effectiveness
