Safety	Without risking safety of the public, understand the public safety implications of an AV Shuttle
Mobility	Understand if AV Shuttle technology can meet TIMMA's intra-island transportation service needs, including first-last mile connections
Operations	Understand TIMMA's organizational capabilities and infrastructure needs to operate an AV shuttle
Research	Gather insights from the public and AV data during pilot and share lessons learned with community and key stakeholders

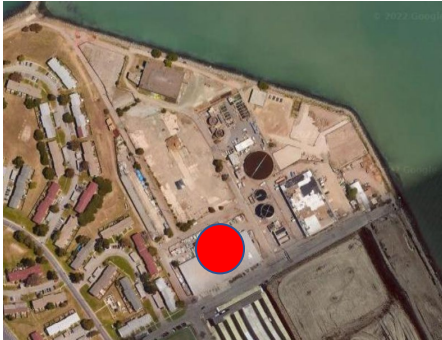

- Submit:
 - Exhibit 10-O1 – Local Agency Consultant Proposal DBE Commitment
 - Exhibit 10-O2 – Consultant Contract DBE Information
 - Exhibit 15-H – DBE Information – Good Faith Efforts (if goal is not achieved)

Additional Proposal Requirements

RFP>Section V

By the proposal due date, primes and subconsultants must submit:

- Exhibit F – Federal Compliance Questionnaire
- Exhibit I – Debarment and Suspension Certification
- Exhibit J – Terminated Contracts
- Exhibit K – Workforce Data Spreadsheets
- Exhibit L – Certification Regarding Lobbying
- Exhibit N – Buy America Certificate (Addendum #1)


