LOCAL ISSUES

Treasure Island Supplemental Transportation Study - Final Working Group Meeting Scheduled. The TI Supplemental Transportation Study is a District 6 Neighborhood Program Planning Project requested by former Chair Haney and approved by the Transportation Authority Board in October 2021. Transportation Authority and One Treasure Island staff presented an update on the study at the October 2022 TIMMA Committee meeting, including the results of outreach activities and a draft short list of supplemental transportation strategies. The study team has drafted a funding and implementation plan for the recommended strategies which correspond to the state Regional Early Action Planning (REAP) grant proposal we submitted in December. One Treasure Island will convene the study's Working Group for their final meeting in early April 2023 to review the final draft recommendations, funding, and implementation approach. We expect to bring the Study's Final Report to the Transportation Authority Board for approval this spring. For more

PROJECT DELIVERY

Treasure Island Autonomous Vehicle Shuttle Pilot - Preparing for Deployment. The autonomous vehicle shuttle (AVS) pilot is a planned nine-month deployment of AVS technology on Treasure Island to provide free rides to the public along a fixed route on Treasure Island. The rides will complement Muni's 25 Treasure Island line, and will have an on-board attendant at all times. We have executed a contract with the AVS vendor, Beep, Inc., and are continuing to plan for community outreach, vehicle testing, and training while Beep seeks federal and state permits. A 30-day vehicle testing period without passengers is expected to begin as early as March 31, 2023 and we expect to begin passenger service in May. Outreach events will take place this spring.
