





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How Residents of District 1 Travel




Resident travel is done primarily by driving.

Understanding Neighborhood Travel Patterns




Mini-Districts are major activity/destination areas.

These districts were used to understand trip making patterns within District 1.




Mode Share for Resident Trips to and from Mini Districts, Starting in District 1



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Trips from District 1 to Areas of San Francisco




About 20% of trips that start in District 1 stay within the District.

Percentage Trip Distribution






Of regional trips, the Peninsula and South Bay are the most common destination for trips starting in District 1.







North-south bike connections in the Outer Richmond to expand and connect the bike network


