Curb Ramps Various Locations No. 18

(SFPW) Construction

Prop L Request: \$1,155,000

Total Cost: \$1,736,037

Construct 30 curb ramps at 7 intersections in Districts 2, 5, 6, and 10, and related sidewalk, curb, and gutter work

- Locations primarily identified through public requests and SFPW inspections
- Open for use by December 2026





Public Sidewalk and Curb Repair


(SFPW) Construction

Prop L Request: \$586,000

Total Cost: \$977,760

Repair damaged public sidewalks, curb and gutters, and angular returns not related to tree damage, at approximately 200 locations

- Locations identified through inspections, complaints, and trip-and-fall accident reports
- SFPW expects to complete this work by June 2026





Street Repair and Cleaning Equipment

(SFPW) Construction

Prop L Request: \$400,000

Total Cost: \$400,000

Purchase one full size street sweeper to replace equipment that has exceeded its useful life

- Equipment will be California Air Resources Board compliant and meet current emissions standards
- SFPW expects this vehicle to be in service by June 2026





Bicycle Safety Education and Outreach

(SFMTA) Construction

Prop L Request: \$200,000

Total Cost: \$200,000

Support safe use of San Francisco streets by providing bicycle safety classes and monthly safety outreach

- At least 68 bike classes expected to be conducted and 12,000 people to be reached through outreach between October 2025 and December 2026
- Increase number of people bicycling safely in San Francisco
- Programs and materials offered in multiple languages
- Special conditions (e.g. SFMTA certification of eligible contractor expenses, evaluation to include demographics/metrics related to outreach and participants)





Neighborhood Transportation Program Coordination

(SFCTA, SFMTA) Planning

Prop L Request: \$100,000 SFCTA \$100,000 SFMTA

Total Cost: \$200,000

Support for a NTP Coordinator role at both the Transportation Authority and SFMTA

- Support Board members' efforts to identify potential NTP projects, develop proposals, and conduct project delivery oversight
- Funds work through June 2026







Various Locations Pavement Renovation No. 90

(SFPW) Construction

Prop AA Request: \$2,360,572

Total Cost: \$5,620,000

Pavement renovation of 46 blocks, construction and retrofit of 29 curb ramps, and related work in Districts 7, 8, and 11

- Prop AA 5-Year Project List amendment
- Open for use by December 2027
