- Open for use expected by September 2027




Prop AA Request: \$1,100,000

Total Cost: \$8,010,000

Revitalize the culturally significant public plaza on Buchanan between Post and Sutter streets in the heart of Japantown

- Scope includes repaving uneven walkways, curb ramps, landscaping, enhancing existing public art, and pedestrian lighting
- Requires Prop AA 5-Year Project List amendment
- Open for use expected by June 2027
