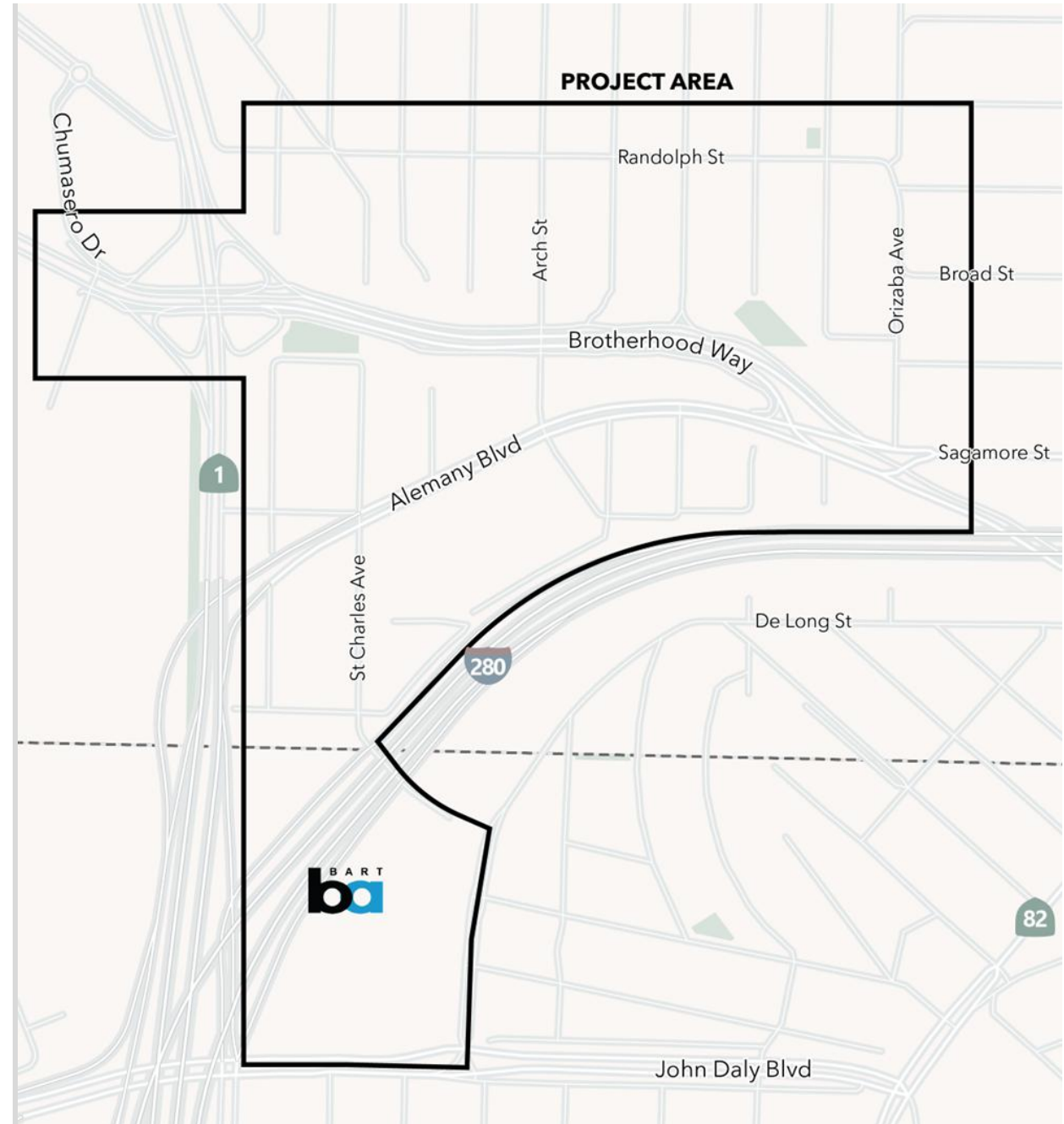

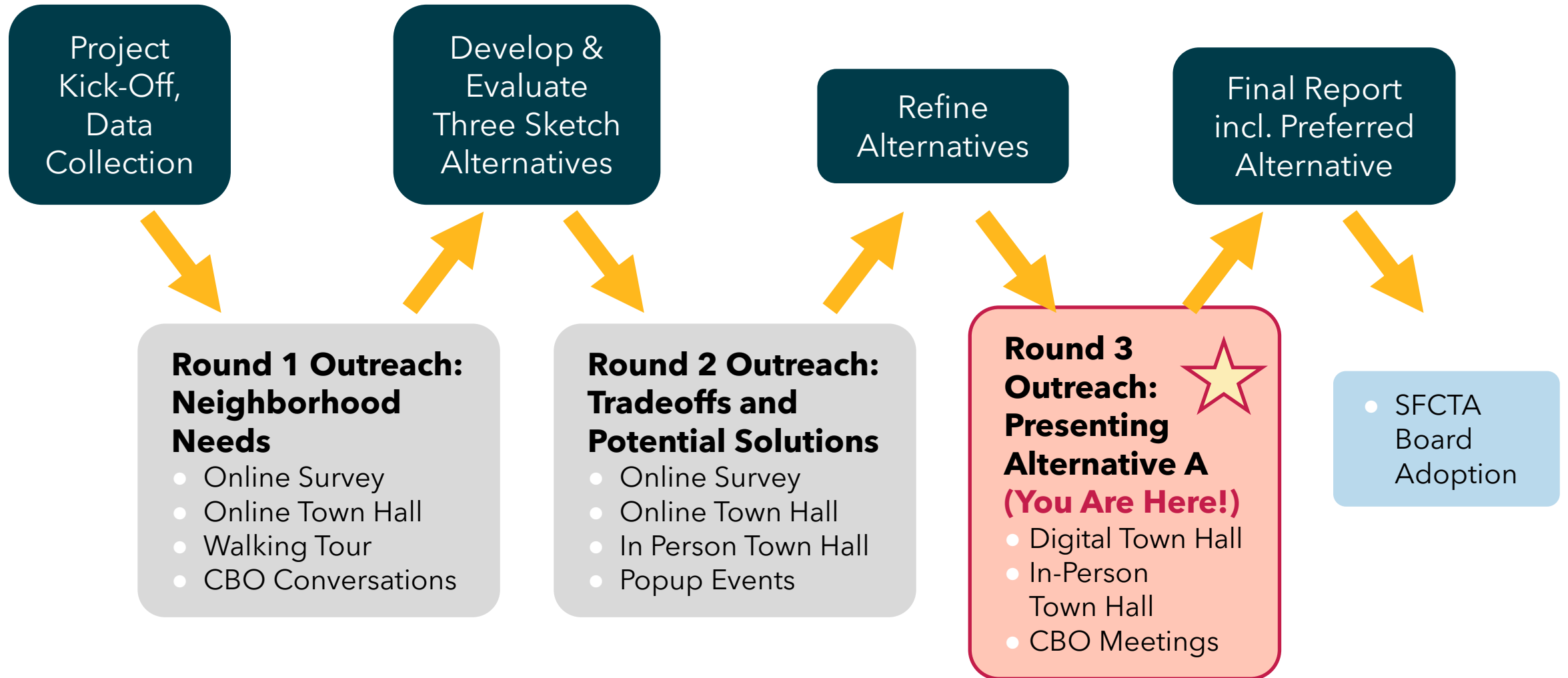

- Funded by a Caltrans Planning Grant with local Prop K match
- Study Goals

 - Support community amenities and green space
 - Prepare for the future
 - Demonstrate accountability

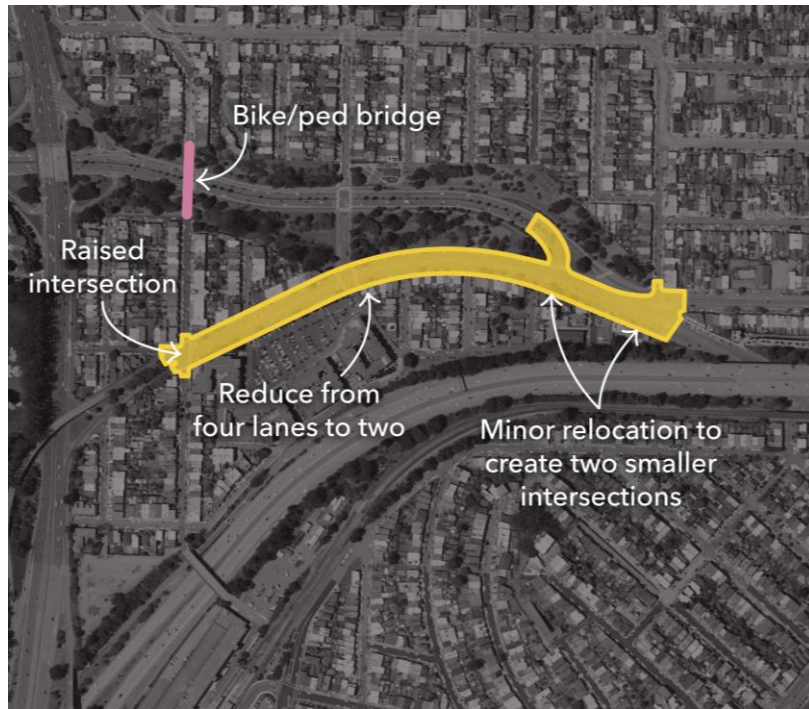

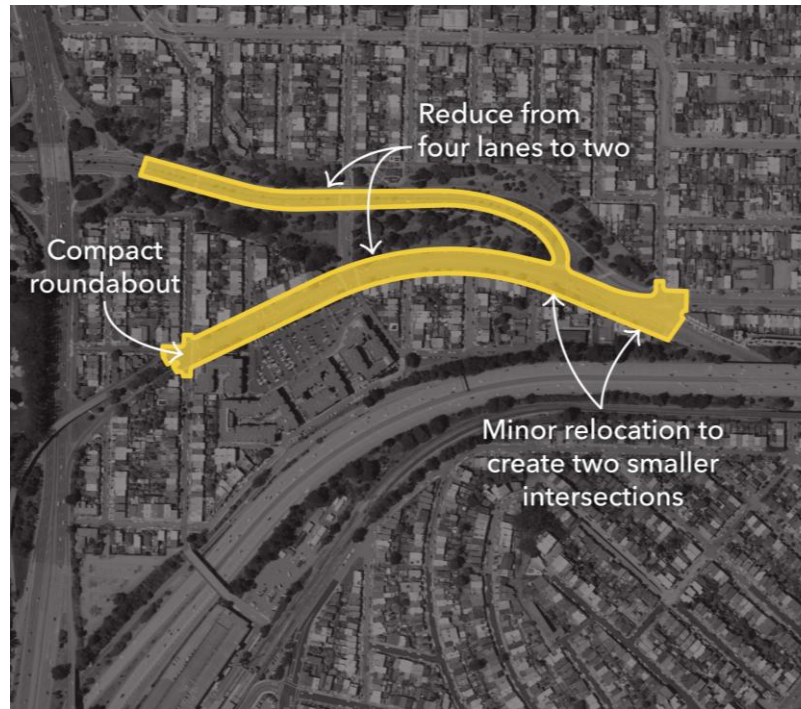


What we discussed last round

Round 2 Community Feedback: Key Takeaways

Across surveys, town halls, and pop-up events, we heard:

- Strong interest in safer crossings and traffic calming, especially at key intersections
- Broad support for improvements that are quicker to implement and lower cost
- Interest in a longer-term vision, especially improved green space and a daylight creek - but also some concerns and open questions about that idea

This feedback shaped how the project team refined the recommendations tonight.



Draft Recommendation

Lower posted speed limit on Brotherhood (completed)

Ramp and bike lane improvements by ParkMerced developers

Automated speed enforcement for Brotherhood and Alemany

Flashing signs (completed)

Raised intersection or crosswalk

Bicycle and pedestrian bridge

Raised crosswalk

Raised and separated bike lanes

Sharrows

One lane in each direction separated bike lanes on Alemany

BART access improvements

Sharrows

Pedestrian signal at dog park

Reconfigure intersection with new signals and improved crossings

 Daly City BART Station

Potential Future: Road Relocation / Alternative C

Community members raised several questions that the city should answer:

- Concurrent land use planning
- Library coordination
- Connections outside the project area
