REGIONAL, STATE AND FEDERAL ISSUES

10 Year Anniversary Bay Bridge East Span Bike Ride to Treasure Island. Bike East Bay & Rails to Trails Conservancy hosted a group bike ride this past Saturday April 25th, to celebrate the 10-year anniversary of the Bay Bridge East Span project and to promote the exciting Transbay Bay Skyway project. Riders started at West Oakland BART with a speaking program, rode up the east span of the Bay Bridge to Yerba Buena Island, paused to learn about the Bay Skyway project, and then resumed the ride up the Bay Trail northward to Berkeley. The Transportation Authority's Yerba Buena Island Multi-Use Pathway Project - currently being constructed as part of the West Side Bridges and Hillcrest Road projects - is part of the Bay Skyway Project (Phase 1 connection by ferry to San Francisco proper). Slated for completion in Fiscal Year 2028, the Bay Skyway will provide another sustainable transbay connection for local and regional residents, workers, and visitors.

San Francisco Bay Ferry celebrates Rapid Electric Emission-Free Ferry (REEF) program and expansion plans. On April 14th, I was honored to join local, regional state and federal elected officials on the State of San Francisco (SF) Bay Ferry tour. SF Bay Ferry highlighted their electrification program, starting with expansions to Treasure Island in 2028 and Mission Bay some time thereafter, pending confirmation of operating funds, followed by Berkeley and Redwood City. We congratulate SF Bay Ferry on their record high ridership in March and 98% passenger satisfaction rate!

PROJECT DELIVERY

Ferry Terminal Enhancements Project. TIMMA is leading this project to construct restrooms and transit shelters at the TI Ferry terminus where Muni's 25 bus line terminates, and where bikeshare stations will be located, on behalf of TIDA. The project

commenced construction in January with structural components taking shape. The project is on time and budget and we anticipate completion in Fall of 2026.

Yerba Buena Island Multi-modal Infrastructure Program - Numerous Projects On Track for Completion this Year.

The Transportation Authority continues to make good progress on the West Side Bridges and Hillcrest Road Improvement projects, which are part of a larger multi-modal infrastructure improvement program on the Islands that supports the Treasure Island Transportation Program. Hillcrest Road - stretching over the Bay Bridge - reached substantial completion in March. The West Side Bridges Retrofit project is about 80% complete and on schedule for completion at the end of this year. The Yerba Buena Island Multi-Use Pathway Project which lies adjacent to the travel lanes on both Hillcrest Road and West Side Bridges, will be delivered in four segments. Segment 1 connecting to the East Span Bay Bridge is in the design phase. Segments 2 and 3 are now in construction through the Hillcrest Road and West Side Bridges projects. Segment 4 on the west side of YBI is anticipated to start construction in July 2026 with the Treasure Island Roadway Improvement project. We are looking forward to more updates on that project in the coming months and celebrating ribbon cuttings with the community. For more information see the project websites:
