Background

- In 2023, the Transportation Authority:
 - Allocated \$270,000 in Prop K Neighborhood Program funds to SFMTA and SFCTA to conduct the District 2 Safety Study (Study) and
 - Placed \$430,000 in Prop K funds on reserve for SFMTA to implement Study recommendations following Board adoption and submittal of project details
- The Board adopted the Study in March 2026



District 2 Safety Study

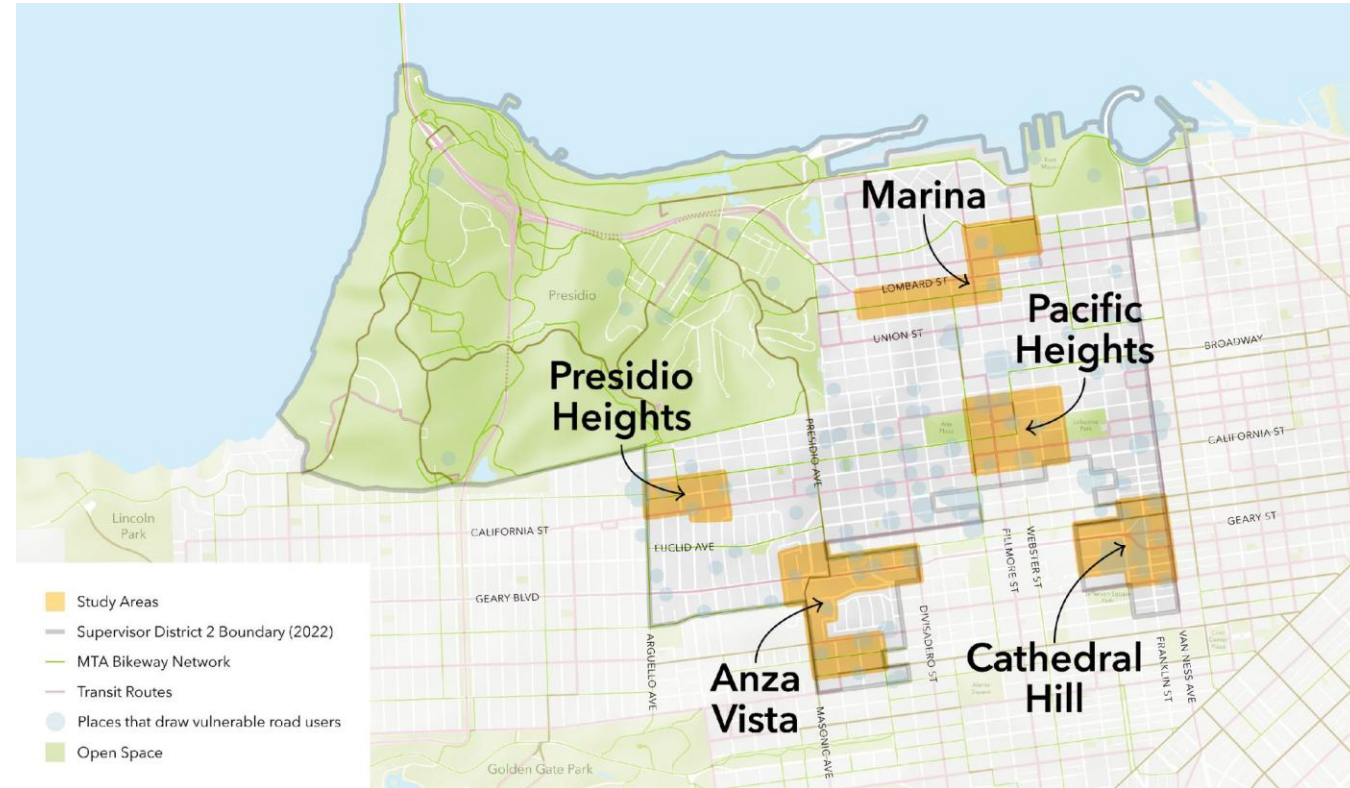
Study Overview

Project Goal

Improve safety and access to places in District 2 that attract vulnerable road users (e.g., children, seniors, and people with disabilities)

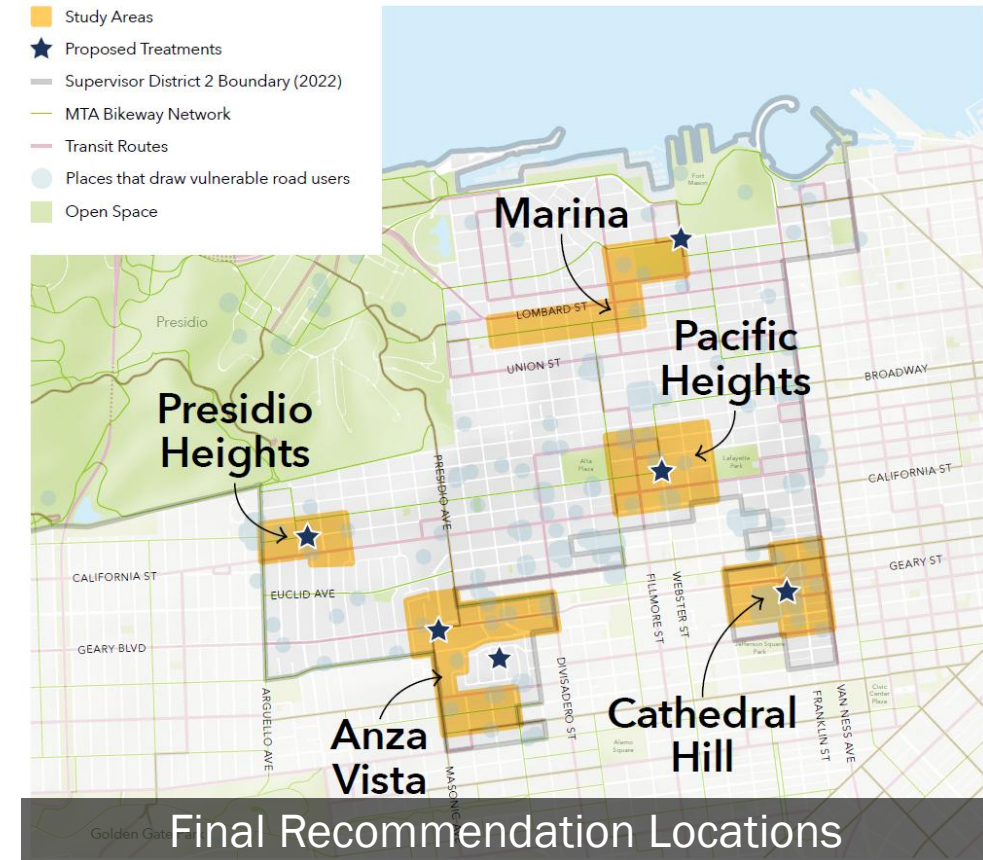
Outcomes

- Design and implement selected quick-build improvements

District 2 Safety Study and Implementation [NTIP Planning and Capital] (Amendment & Release of Reserve Funds) (SFMTA) Design, Construction

Prop L Request: \$430,000

Total Cost: \$439,059

- Proposed scope includes painted safety zones, traffic signal upgrades and modifications, new traffic signs and bicycle wayfinding, and traffic island/median reconfigurations
- 10 locations in the study area
- SFMTA expects the project will be open for use by June 2028

- Amend the Prop K Standard Grant Agreement for the District 2 Safety Study and Implementation [NTIP Planning and Capital] project to update the scope, schedule, cost, and funding plan
- Release \$430,000 on reserve to implement the District 2 Safety Study near-term recommendations
