One Bay Area Grant Cycle 4 (OBAG 4)

The Metropolitan Transportation Commission's (MTC's) OBAG program directs federal funds to projects that advance implementation of the Regional Transportation Plan

OBAG 4 continues the structure of past cycles with regional and county programs that invest in transportation, housing, and land use to help achieve state greenhouse gas reduction goals

OBAG 4 County Program

About \$319 million available region wide

- Covers four Fiscal Years, from 2027 to 2030
- Rewards jurisdictions that accept and produce housing, particularly affordable housing
- Targets investments in Priority Development Areas and Transit-Oriented Communities
- Flexibility to support local priorities

MTC guidelines require that county transportation agencies like SFCTA will

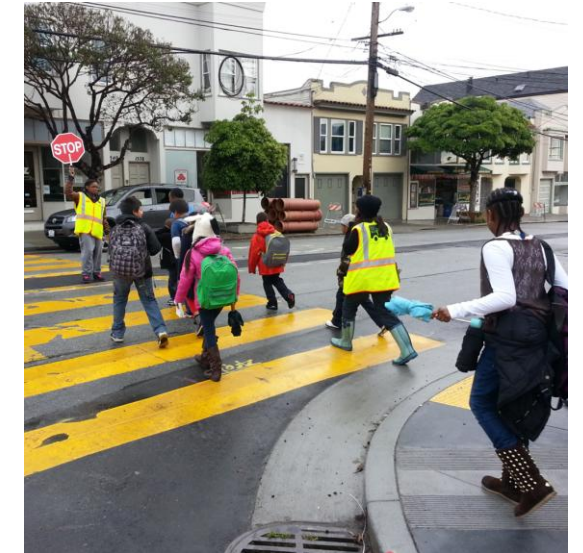
- Conduct call for projects, in partnership with MTC
- Use MTC evaluation criteria to select projects (may add county specific criteria)
- Submit project nominations to MTC by October 31, 2026

MTC evaluates and selects projects for funding

OBAG 4 County Program

Broad project eligibility consistent with federal fund sources including:

- Transit reliability and access
- Local road safety, complete streets
- Safe Routes to School Non-Infrastructure program
- State of good repair for transit and local roads

Screening Criteria (partial list)

- Consistent with Plan Bay Area 2050+
- Eligible project type
- Ability to meet timely use of funds deadlines
- Minimum request of \$500,000 OBAG funds
- 11.47% local match
- Adhere to Caltrans Local Assistance Procedures Manual selection and contracting requirements (federal funds)

Prioritization Criteria (partial list)

- Project readiness and deliverability
- Multi-modal benefits
- Safety
- State of good repair
- Transit reliability and accessibility
- Community support
- Benefits to disadvantaged populations
- Other criteria such as: Access to schools, senior centers, other community sites; Environmental sustainability; Fund leveraging

OBAG 4 Competitive Call for Projects

MTC Scoring Process

MTC will evaluate and score nominated projects

- 75 points: normalize County scores across the region
- Up to 25 points: delivery and risk, regional alignment, and federal system performance goals
- Up to 10 bonus points: air quality benefits

MTC may balance project prioritization based on:

- Variety of project types
- Equitable investments
- Geographic spread

OBAG 4 Competitive Call for Projects Applications Received

Call for Projects Schedule

- **April 17:** Released Call for Projects
- **July 7:** Application deadline

We received 14 applications requesting \$89.2 million versus our \$48.7 million nomination target (120%).
