



Priority Development Areas in San Francisco

Priority Development Areas (PDAs) are locally-identified infill development opportunity areas within existing communities that are primed for a pedestrian- and bicycle-friendly environment served by transit. At least 70% of San Francisco's OBag funds must be given to projects in PDAs in order to support location of new jobs and housing near transit. A project outside a PDA but connecting to or providing access to a PDA may count toward the minimum.
