Hello TWG members,

Thank you for submitting the info on new or revised non-exempt projects (i.e. exempt from air quality conformity analysis) for the 2017 TIP update earlier this year. Now comes the main round of incorporating new projects or changes to existing projects for both exempt and non-exempt projects to FMS. The FMS entries are due:

- non-transit projects: save in FMS, and notify Seon Joo Kim (seonjoo.kim@sfcta.org) with cc Mike Pickford (mike.pickford@sfcta.org) by 3/29/16
- transit projects: submit in FMS by 4/14/16

Please note you cannot start the FMS revision until 3/17 but can start reviewing projects now using the "Project Detail Report" (see p.2 and Att B of MTC's guidance memo, attached).

Please carefully read MTC's guidance memo in its entirety for instructions and requirements, including Areas to Focus Your Review (the page number references MTC's memo):

- Archive completed, canceled, or duplicate projects, esp. those without funding in the 2017 TIP period (p.3)
- Add new projects (p.3-4)
- Check RTP ID, esp. scope, cost, and project completion year/air quality conformity analysis year (p.4)
- Update project description, esp. jurisdiction, limits, and scope, specifying any non-exempt elements (p.4-5)
- Update funding, esp. committed funds within the 2017 TIP period and uncommitted (RTP-LRP) funds in the future (p.5-6)
- Update other info, esp. location, milestones, contact, and project-level PM 2.5 air quality (p.6)

Important caveats include:

- For non-exempt elements or projects, only those proposed as part of the January submittal will be allowed.
- The projects must be consistent with the current Plan Bay Area, not the Plan Bay Area 2040 update in progress; the 2017 TIP update effort for the Plan Bay Area 2040 will commence in summer/fall 2016.
